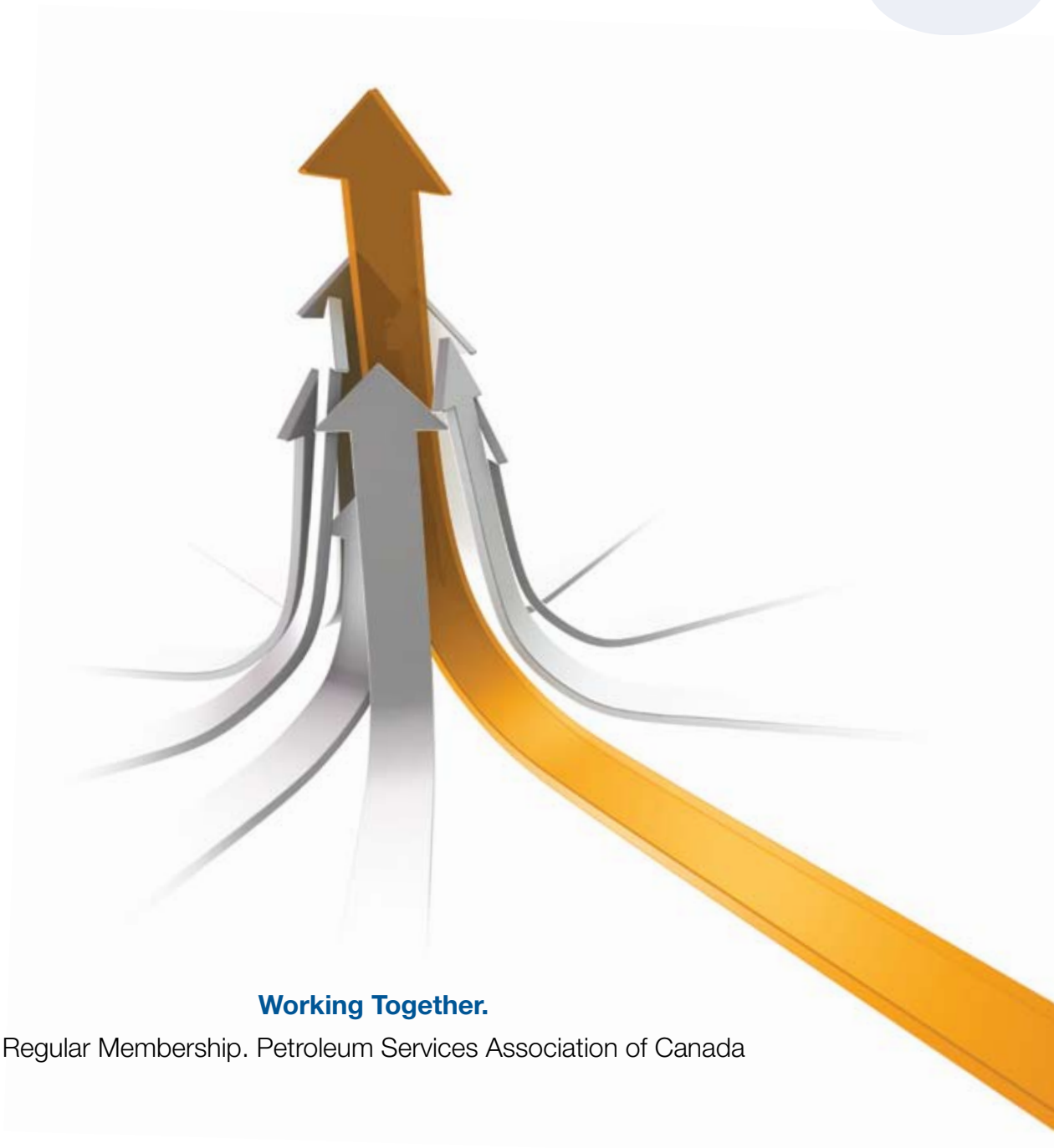

## PSAC Member Benefits

### 1) Benefit From a Collective Voice

Provide your feedback on PSAC's advocacy efforts with governments, producer companies, regulators, the public, and bring your company's issues forward to benefit from the strength of PSAC's collective voice.

### 2) Participate on Standing Committees

Participate on any of PSAC's Standing Committees which are designed to tackle issues facing the entire petroleum services industry.
