

2019 Remember Jordan Scholarship Funded by Ditch Hitch

Rules and Regulations

Objective

This scholarship was established in remembrance of Jordan Roppel, who passed away in 2004 after being struck by the shank of a trailer ball during a summer job. In recognition of the danger associated with shock loading arising from improper training or equipment, PSAC Affiliate member, Ditch Hitch, worked with PSAC to establish the **Remember Jordan** campaign to raise awareness of the dangers of shock load vehicle recovery. Award

One \$2,500 scholarship will be paid in 2019.

Eligibility

Applicant must be:

1. A Canadian citizen.
2. 25 years of age or less as of June 30, 2019.
3. The birth, step or adopted child of an employee with a PSAC Core member company in good standing.
4. Registered at an accredited post-secondary institution in one of the following programs: Business, Engineering, Health & Safety or Trades/Apprenticeship.
5. Able to demonstrate commitment to the community through volunteer, extra-curricular or other activities.

Note: recipients may be asked to provide proof that they meet the above criteria. Preference will be given to those pursuing a Trades/Apprenticeship or Engineering Program and who reside in a rural community.

Award Procedures

All applications submitted will be reviewed to confirm eligibility. A committee will select the scholarship recipient based on a combination of community service, extra-curricular activities and academic performance from all eligible applications received. The scholarship recipient will be notified in writing. Applicants are eligible to win only one PSAC scholarship per year. Any applicants who applied in previous years may reapply; however, past PSAC scholarship recipients are not eligible.

Applicants not selected to receive a scholarship will not be directly contacted by PSAC. Instead, they are encouraged to visit the PSAC website at www.pfac.ca in June for information on award recipients.

Scholarship funding is issued in the recipient's name directly to the educational institution upon receipt of written confirmation of admission and enrollment of the recipient. An authorized representative of the educational institution must submit confirmation to PSAC of the recipient's enrollment, including the recipient's student ID number and contact information. By submitting proof of enrollment, the educational institution acknowledges that the funds received will be applied to tuition fees or other educational expenses (e.g., personal computer hardware/software, textbooks, etc.) and that any balance remaining at the end of the semester year will be carried forward on behalf of the recipient. Any balance remaining after graduation or termination of enrollment is to be refunded to the PSAC Education Fund by the educational institution.

Application Deadline

All applications must be completed online at www.pfac.ca by 4:30 p.m., Friday, May 3, 2019.

Incomplete applications or those submitted after the deadline will not be accepted. It is the applicant's responsibility to notify PSAC of any changes to the information submitted on the application.
